**2nd Annual Chili Cook Off**  
**Saturday, November 11**  
**Cook Off Rules and Regulations**

1. There will be two entry categories for the cook off:

**Category 1:** Meat with Beef

**Category 2:** Vegetarian/All other meats (pork, chicken, wild game)

Teams will be required to commit to one of the categories on the registration form.

2. Teams are limited to 4 people per team.
3. Teams will be allowed to choose their tent location in order of registration forms received. First team to sign up gets first choice of tent location, etc.
4. Meats may be pre-cooked, and vegetables may be pre-chopped. All other cooking must be done on site. All cooking may begin as early as 7 am and should be ready to serve at 12:00 pm on November 11.
5. Each team must cook a minimum of 5 gallons to serve at the cook off, but teams are encouraged to make more. There is a People's Choice Award so the more chili served, the better chance of winning this award.
6. All teams must supply their own cooking utensils, pots, and ingredients. CTK Life Teen will provide serving cups, spoons, and napkins. All chili will be served in a 3oz. cup.
7. All teams must come equipped with burners, propane tanks, and generators as needed on the day of the event.
8. Each team will be given a number and an 8 oz cup for each judge. Judging will begin at 12:30pm.
9. All teams must bring their own 10x10 tent with their own tables and chairs. Teams may bring their own drinks. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed.
10. Teams are encouraged to come up with a unique team name and decorate their tent with a theme. Prize will be given to the top decorated tent.
11. Prizes will be given to the top two teams in each category in addition to a top prize given to the "People's Choice."

1st Place Prize: Cash and prize package valuing up to \$400

2nd Place Prize: Cash and prize package valuing up to \$200

12. Registered Team Members do not need to purchase a ticket for the day of the event.
13. Judges will judge the chili based on the following considerations: good chili flavor, texture of the meat, consistency, blend of spices, aroma, and color.
14. In the event of rain, the cook off will be held in the breezeway of the school and in the school gym.
15. Deadline for registration is **Friday, November 3.**
