## CTK YOUTH MINISTRY BATHING SUIT POLICY

Bathing suits for guys and girls should be modest. If students have any questions about whether it is modest enough, they should not bring it. Two pieces can be worn, but triangle tops are not allowed—girls’ bathing suits cannot make any kind of “v” in the chest. String bikinis (tops and bottoms) are not allowed. If girls do not have a bathing suit that fits into these criteria, they can wear a colored t-shirt over it. Guys may not wear shorts that are see-through when wet, too short, or advertise inappropriate content (including alcohol or other products which are illegal for middle schoolers to use). Chaperones may ask students to wear a tshirt or shorts over the bathing suit (or change) if they agree it is not appropriate.

On July 23-27, Edge will be program helpers at **Camp Creation**, an organization which serves underserved communities in Foley. “The entire Program will be rooted in the Word of God with additional emphasis on achieving academic excellence (math, reading and language arts), promote self- awareness, citizenship/character building, and improve social skills among peers.”



Edge students are encouraged to participate in the entire week, just like VBS at CTK. We will leave CTK at 7:45 am to Liberty Church and return at 2 pm. Please detach and return with \$15 by July 15.
